1. Danube Health Conference

Summer 2012 in Ulm, Baden-Württemberg

The aim of the 1st Danube Health Conference should be to get to know the structures of health services provided beyond one's borders, to learn from one another by comparing of good practices and to draft guidelines for joint action. This will encourage a Danube-wide interchange of views, networking and the development of joint strategies in searching for solutions.

The delegates from the Danube's riparian states at this Conference should turn their attention to cross-border co-operation in health services. Persons in key positions in health services should be given the opportunity within the scope of this European interchange of experience to secure and improve health services for the inhabitants of Danube countries. The Conference must also discuss their differences and create the basis for future co-operations.

And it should widen the existing bilateral activities between the Danube countries where health is concerned to a multilateral networking and should discuss health themes of common interest in the framework of the Danube strategy.
